It's like a man named Jacob. He used to walk around his town, always complaining. He complained about his age and his children and his wife and about anything he could think of. Then, one day, Jacob complained to the rabbi and his students. As he departed, they said to him, "May you be blessed." Months went by before the rabbi and his students saw Jacob again. When they did, Jacob had changed his ways. Jacob was now able to see all of his complaints as blessings. He was thankful that his years of manual labor gave him the strength to do his job. He was happy that his children were studious and worked hard in school. And he recognized that his wife asked him to do things because she needed him, and he needed her. During these few months, Jacob was able to recognize the blessings in his life.

This is why we are taught to thank God for the blessings in our lives. Reciting blessings teaches us to look at the world around us in a different way – to look at it with more optimism and hope. It teaches us to be happy with what we have, to enjoy the life we have been dealt. By saying the Motzi before we eat, recognize that we have been blessed with food on our table. May we all take a few moments each day to recognize the good in our lives and, in doing so, may we all recognize how blessed we truly are every single day.

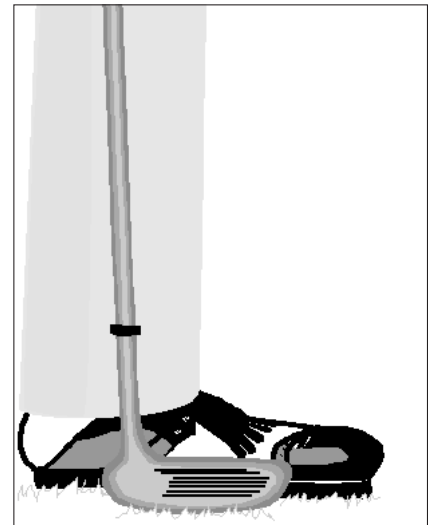
